Noteworthy Legislation

- **ு** HB 1860 Relating to the HCDA
 - Establishes a contested case proceeding process
 - Requires that no amendment to the Kakaako Community Development Plan/Rules shall take effect w/o prior approval of the Legislature
 - Establishes New Community Engagement & Public Notice Requirements
- **ு** HB 1861 Relating to the HCDA
 - **7** Establishes contested case hearing, judicial review process
 - Community Engagement & Public Notice Requirements
 - Density (FAR) set at 3.5, Height at 400 feet

Noteworthy Legislation

- **ு** HB 1863 Relating to the HCDA
 - Revokes appropriation for CIP Project Staff, Removes FTE count for ED & assistant
 - **尽** Sets Minimum Horizontal Separation at 300′, FAR at 1.5
 - Establishes Citizen Suit
- **ு** HB 1864 Relating to the HCDA
 - Repeals the Agency
 - Establishes 1 year transition work group
 - 7 Transfers staff to DBEDT

Noteworthy Legislation

- **₹** HB 1865 Relating to the HCDA
 - Establishes a 1 Year Moratorium where agency is prohibited from approving plans/proposal for development
- **ு** HB 1866 Relating to the HCDA
 - Amends the manner in which members of the Authority are appointed
 - Establishes New Legislative Oversight for the Agency
- **ு** HB 1867 Relating to the HCDA
 - Establishes Minimum Tower Spacing of 300', Height at 400'
 - Requires Project Eligibility Review, Mauka-Makai Axis Only


