

# Parks and Open Spaces

- ▶ HCDA rules require developers to reserve areas for public open spaces
- ▶ Go beyond passive green areas and create active, family friendly open spaces
  - ▶ Boost the energy and activities in the area to increase park usage
  - ▶ More “body heat” discourages the homeless from taking over open spaces



# Howard Hughes Corp. Master Plan

- ▶ Proposes 3.44 acres of open space
  - ▶ 3.25 acre central plaza near Ward Centers
  - ▶ Several smaller plazas nearby, all joined by a pedestrian pathway that runs parallel to Ala Moana Blvd.

# Kamehameha Schools Master Plan

- ▶ Proposes about 3 acres of open space
  - ▶ Public square
  - ▶ Green belt connecting Mother Waldron Park and Kakaako Gateway Parks
