Moving time is upon us and the Hawaii Community Development Authority will officially open for business at the historic American Brewery Building at 7:45 a.m. on March 16, 2015. The State Senate confirmed all of the new nominees last month, and on March 1, 2015, the new Authority began its term, per Act 61. The meeting will be held in the community room located on the first floor of the American Brewery Building, which can be accessed from the courtyard at Honuakaha, off Queen Street.
