§15-220-38	Agricultural use and structures	This section is taken (verbatim) from HRS 48-88, Agricultural Buildings, which allows certain exemptions for agricultural buildings.  For structures larger than 1,000 s.f., a Rules Clearance permit is required.
§15-220-39	Building form	Establishes height limits.
§15-220-40	Architectural design	Establishes architectural design, including: (1) Guidelines for structures; (2) Fences and walls; (3) Lighting; and (4) Signage.
§15-220-41	Parking	Establishes parking requirements.
§15-220-42	Landscape	Establishes, where applicable, native or adaptive plan species should be used or hardscaped with permeable material.

§15-220-43	Historical and cultural sites	Establishes requirement of preserving, protecting and/or restoring historic properties identified in the He'eia CDD.
§15-220-44	Temporary uses	Allows for temporary uses for up to 30 days, provided that the ED may grant an extension of an additional 30 days.

§15-220-56	Rules clearance permit	Establishes procedures for obtaining a Rules Clearance Permit.
§15-220-57	Facility permit	Establishes procedures for obtaining a Facility Permit.
§15-220-58	Conditional use permit	Establishes procedures for obtaining a Conditional Use Permit.
§15-220-59	Variances	Establishes procedures for obtaining a Variance.
§15-220-60	Completeness review	Establishes completeness review process for permit applications.
§15-220-61	Automatic approvals	Establishes automatic approval periods for permits.
