Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation (HHFDC), Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism, State of Hawaii, will hold a public hearing on October 12, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. at the HHFDC Boardroom, 677 Queen Street, Suite 300, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, on the adoption of amendments to and compilation of Chapter 15-306, "General Excise Tax Exemptions," Hawaii Administrative Rules. All are invited to state their views on the proposed amendments orally or in writing. The proposed rule amendments implement Act 95, Session Laws of Hawaii 2015, by adding in the law's new minimum requirements to qualify for the General Excise Tax exemption. Also proposed are program fee increases, and a new section allowing the recertification of exemption of affordable rents for existing rental housing projects that have changed ownership, but otherwise still meet all program requirements.
