Project Awards

The Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation (HHFDC) has approximately \$52,669,436 of uncommitted funds available for eligible Rental Housing Revolving Fund loans in connection with the Fiscal Year 2016 Funding Round 2 and the Fiscal Year 2017 Funding Round 1. Currently, the Rental Housing Revolving Fund has pending applications of approximately \$11,250,000, subject to approval of the Board of Directors of the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation.

All applications will be subject to funding availability and eligibility/qualifying guidelines of the program. Funds may be used for development, construction, acquisition, preservation, and substantial rehabilitation of rental housing units that meet the program's criteria for eligibility.
