- 1. Grant Submission Updates:
  - 2/25: Working on submission for Fire Mitigation Grant (invited to apply).
  - Waiting to hear regarding WaterSMART Grant submitted.
  - Attending DOD CIP Listening Sessions to begin writing DCIP2025.
- 2. Incident Report:

- 4. Meetings and Collaborations:
  - Regular Meetings with Kekaha Ag Association (KAA) in further understanding the systems, challenges & opportunities
  - Meeting with HDOE and Culinary Institute of America
    - i. San Antonio Independent School has 17 districts, focus was one that serves
      50,000 students using a Central Warehouse Model
      - 500 employees were trained in execution of new skills and menus by CIA- reducing workplace injuries, turnover, increasing retention, netting 100% reimbursement by USDA, and school meal participation rates grew
      - 2. Be mindful of the amount of electricity needed for food processing
      - 3. Need to lobby the USDA for a change in "Commodity" listing to include HI staples- sweet potatoes, more fish, etc.
    - ii. Hawaii Ag Foundation just concluded a student survey with over 600 HI students regarding what/how students want to eat
    - iii. Toured an Elementary School cafeteria during lunch service
      - LOVED the "Sharing Table for Students" idea- students can leave whole fruit, unopened fruit cups, cereal bars, breakfast kits, unopened milk and juice for other students to take home
    - iv. Cost Savings Ideas: Milk reuse of cartons kept at temp, designing meals to reduce costs using labor and materials/packaging savings
    - v. Incentives for workers: Certificates and New uniforms
  - Things to consider egg cracking facility- schools buy already cracked/in carton; no need for a USDA meat inspector if meat is consumed in state- do need if shipping to mainland
  - Meetings with HDOE regarding Kauai and Whitmore projects- contract discussion/changes

- Continuous meetings regarding CIP projects.

# 6. Staffing and Operations:

- Hiring updates: offer extended to Accountant IV position-awaiting her decision, submitted paperwork for Climate Resilient Food & Product Innovation Network
   Manager, completed Form B forms for the Kauai staffing positions. Forms are routed through ASO, Director and then Governor.
- Ongoing UHCDC work regarding the forage drying facility and FPINs projects, now being called the Entrepreneurial Product Innovation Network (EPIC)
- The Waiahole System Team are actively using rented equipment to clear debris from the system.
- New office cubicles will arrive 11/12-14 to provide a location for new staff joining ADC.
- New phones and computers are awaiting installation dates.
- Purchase of vehicles for Kauai Staff has started.

## 7. Capital Improvements:

 Advancing projects such as Aahoaka Reservoir, Christian Crossing Bridge, Kekaha Ditch Bridge Crossing, and Kekaha Post Harvest Processing Center (Ken has submitted forms for fund release).

# 8. Grants and Agreements:

- DLNR requested input regarding the transition of future Irrigation Systems to ADC Portfolio.
- Drafted MOAs with the AG's office for HIDOE (Kauai & Oahu) for review.
- Held meetings regarding the Waimea Watershed Agreement to determine the next steps.
- Working on contract extension with Spire, a forensic accounting company. Of the original 8 projects, 6 have been completed with the funding allotted and we are refining the scope moving forward.
- Collaborating with staff to create the FY26 budget, which includes FY24 actuals.

### 9. Project Management:

- Continuing oversight on the HPP (Received 6 Notice of Intents from Companies who will be bidding, 2 completed Statement of Qualification) and Central Oahu Food Hub projects.
- Managing LOI for Oahu parcels and planning next steps for PSAs.
- Staff are working to create a Land Portfolio by Year End.
- Staff are also reviewing an Accounting System Manual.
