    - iii. Project Scope:
      - 1. <u>ADC's Role:</u> Build 14MG reservoir; dual FMs from Wahiawa WWTP to new ADC 14mg reservoir (eta: 7/2030)
      - <u>City's Role:</u> Improve Wahiawa WWTP Recycled Water effluent pump station (eta: 6/2026), HDOH R-1 Certification, WWTP improvements (12/2031)
    - iv. Current Status at ADC: Phase 2 & 3 plans and design have not been funded yet
      - 1. Phase 1: Transmission waterline from WWTP to GAL to transmit R-1 Water
      - 2. Phase 2: Interconnecting pipelines to integrate the R-1 waterline with the GAL irrigation system
      - 3. Phase 3: Lake in-take pump station at Lake Wilson

  - Working with HDOA for JV of the \$5M for WIS acquisition
  - Working with Dole, Sustainable Hawaii and DLNR on the WIS
  - Staff are working to create a Land Portfolio by Year End.
