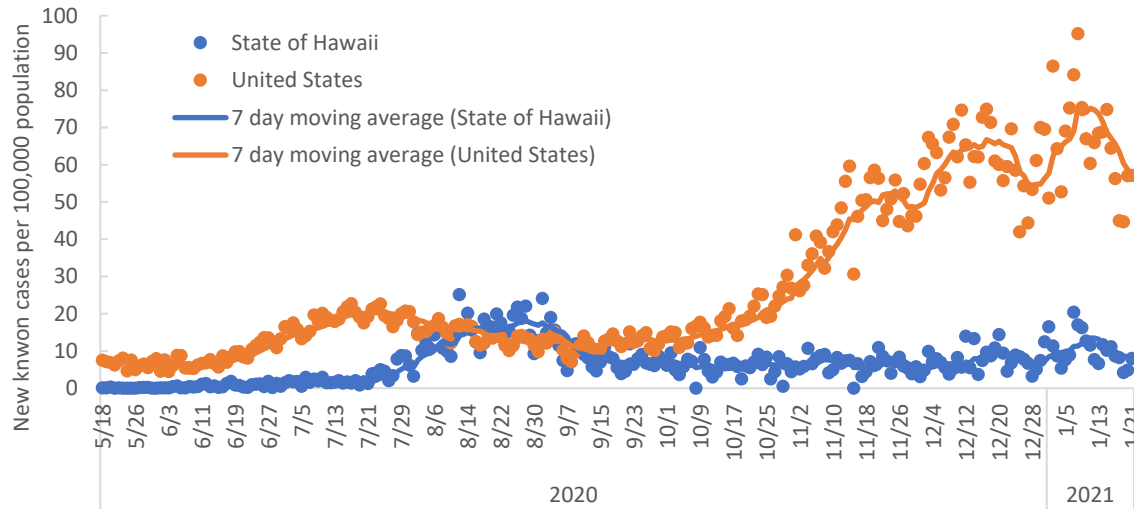

Daily New COVID-19 Cases per 100,000 Population

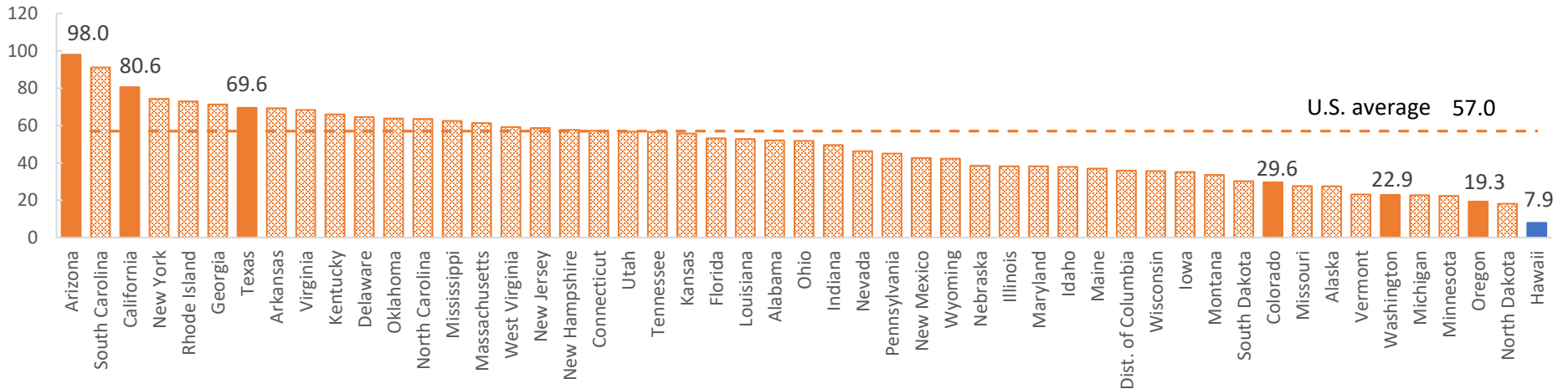

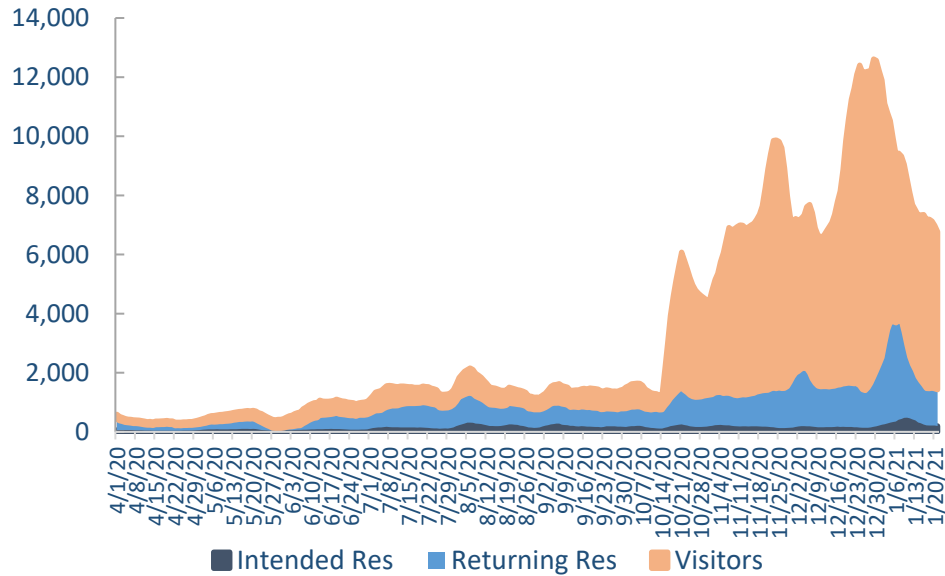

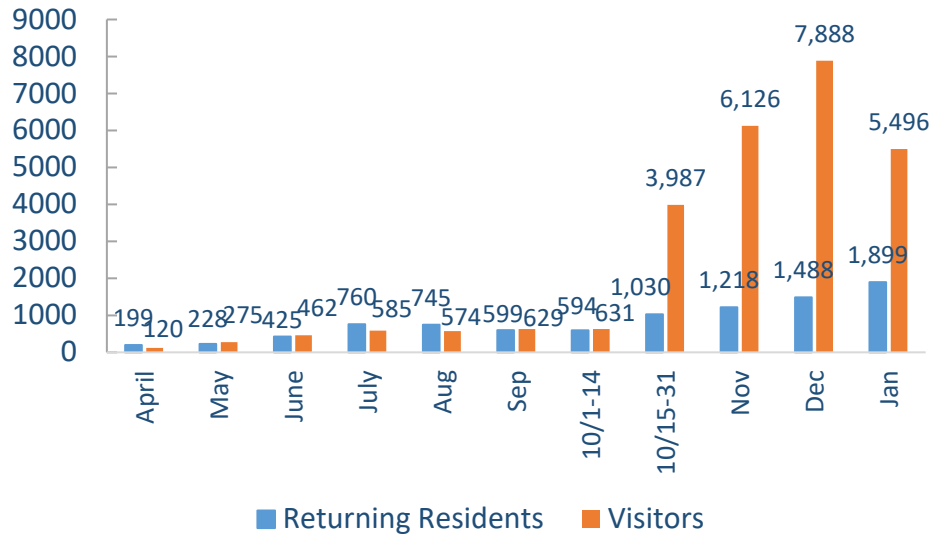

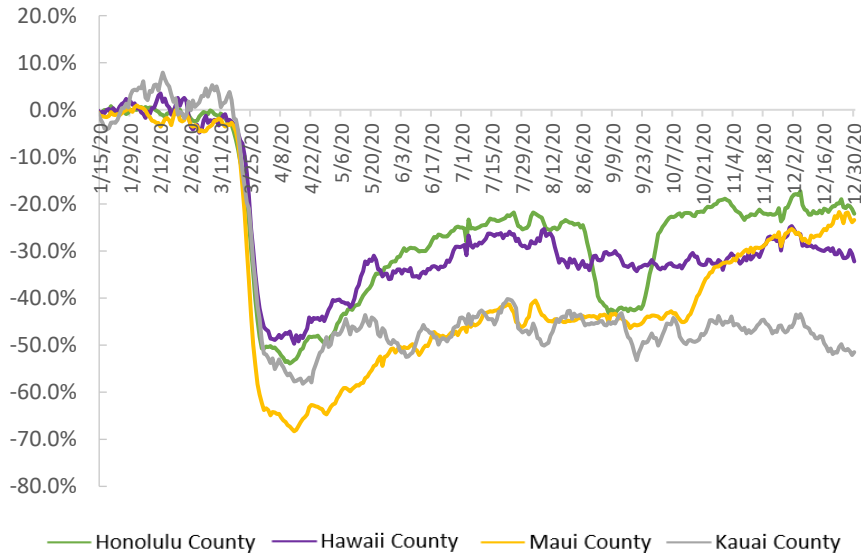

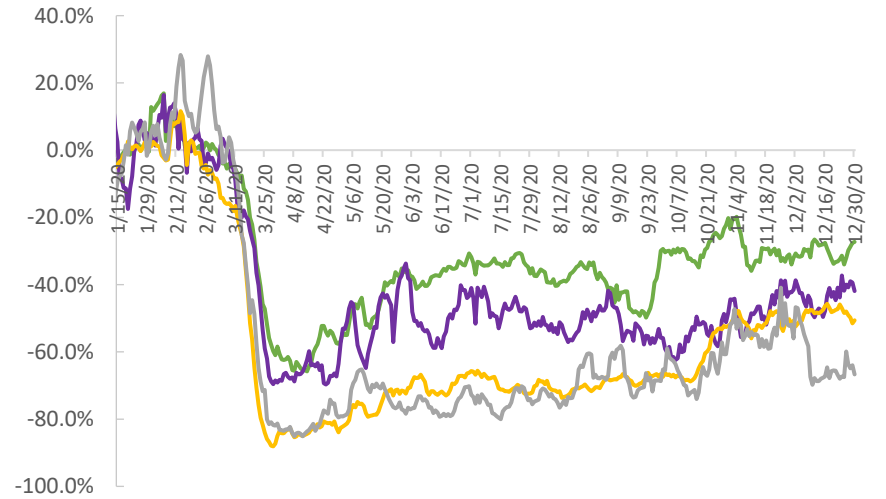

(Compared to January 2020)

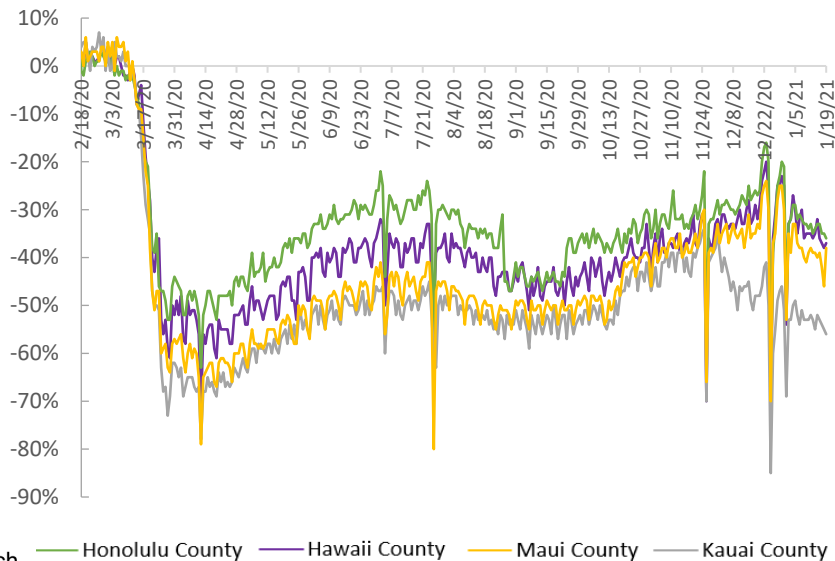


Percent Change in Small Business Revenue
(Compared to January 2020)

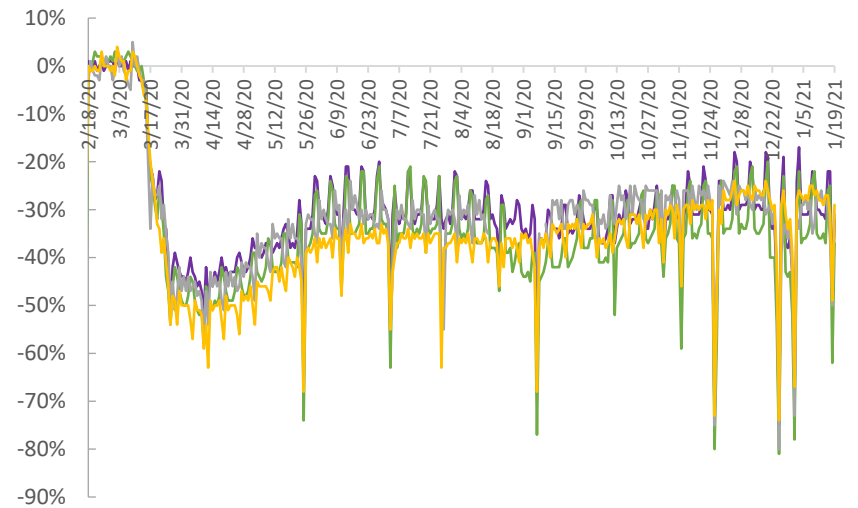

9.9% of businesses had increased revenue, and **36.9%** of businesses had decreased revenues



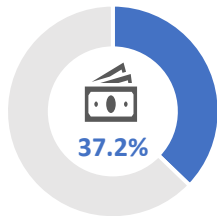
23.0% of businesses had delays in delivery or shipping to customers



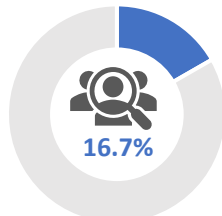
24.0% of businesses had domestic supplier delays

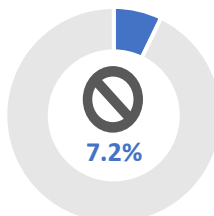

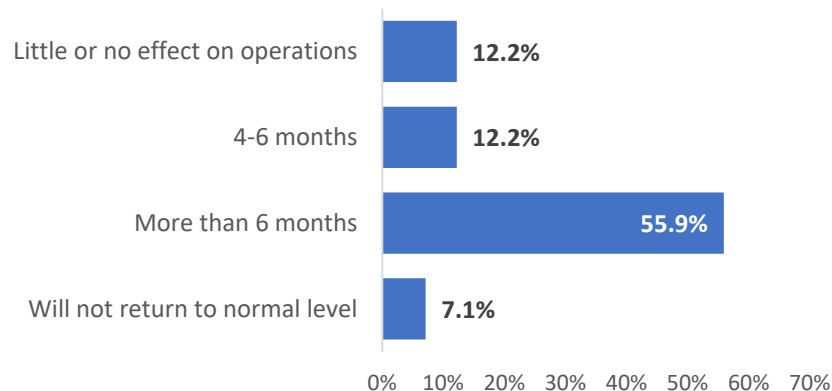

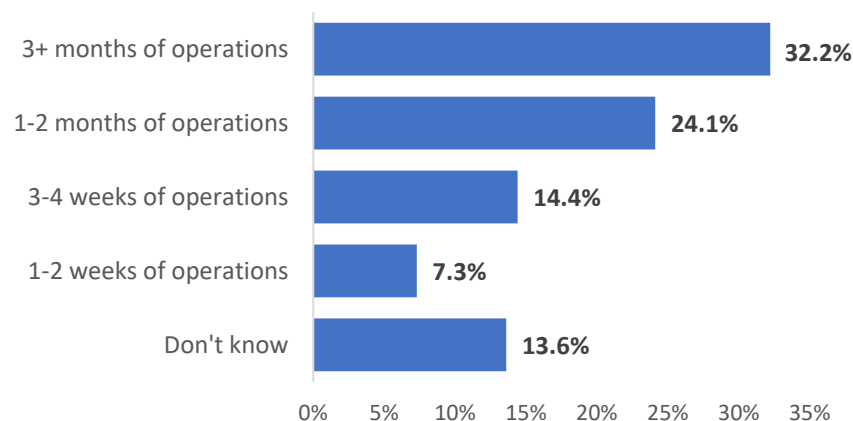

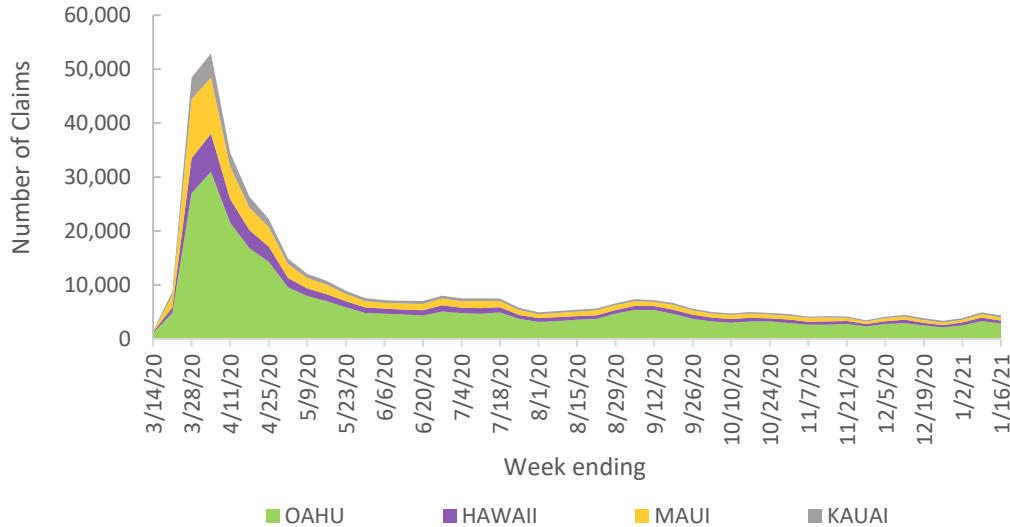

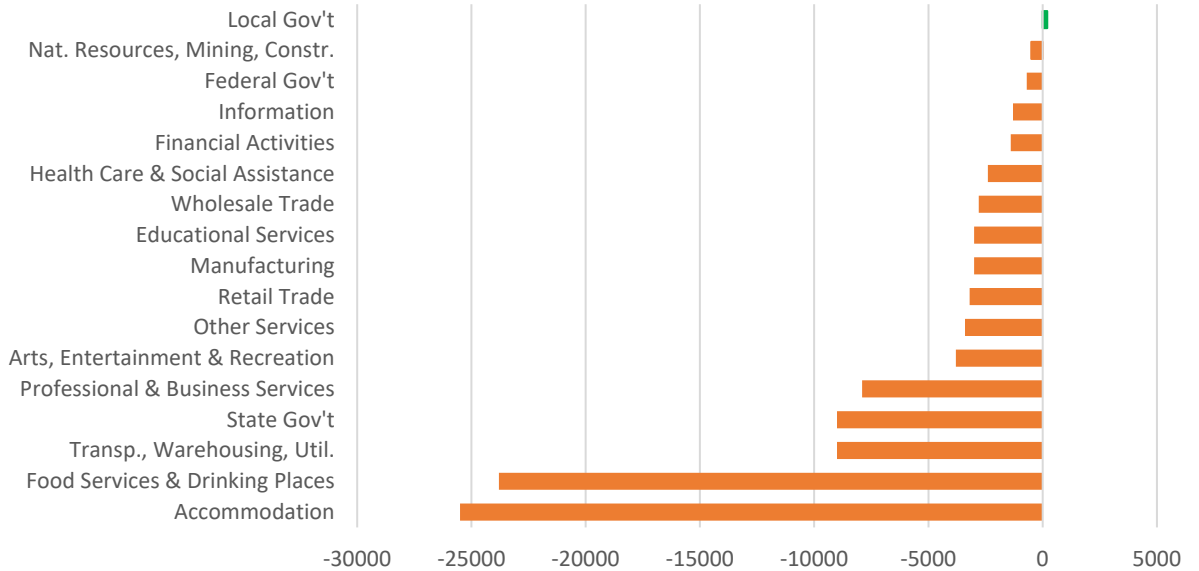

Change in Jobs from Prior Year (Current Month) November 2020

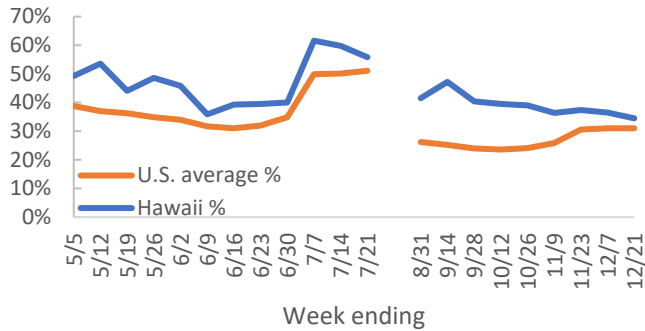

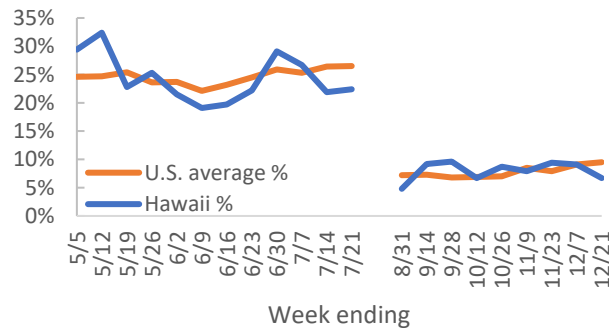

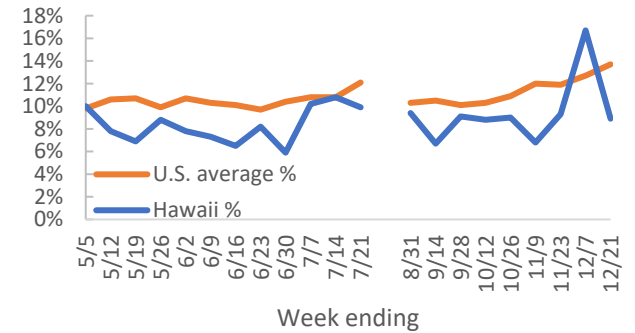
Expect someone in their household to lose employment income in the next 4 weeks



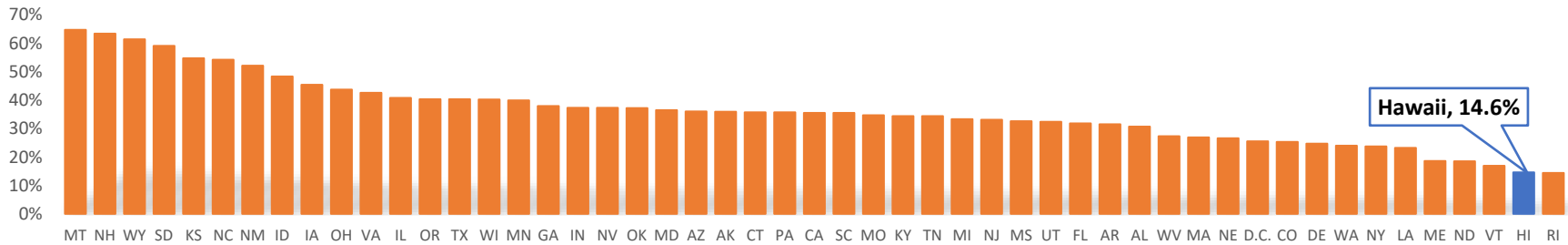
Missed rent/mortgage payments or plan to in the next month



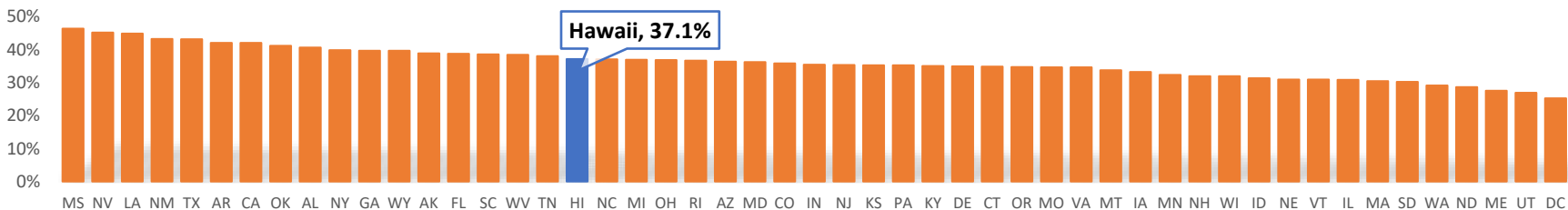
At times did not have not enough to eat in the last 7 days

Find it difficult to pay usual household expenses

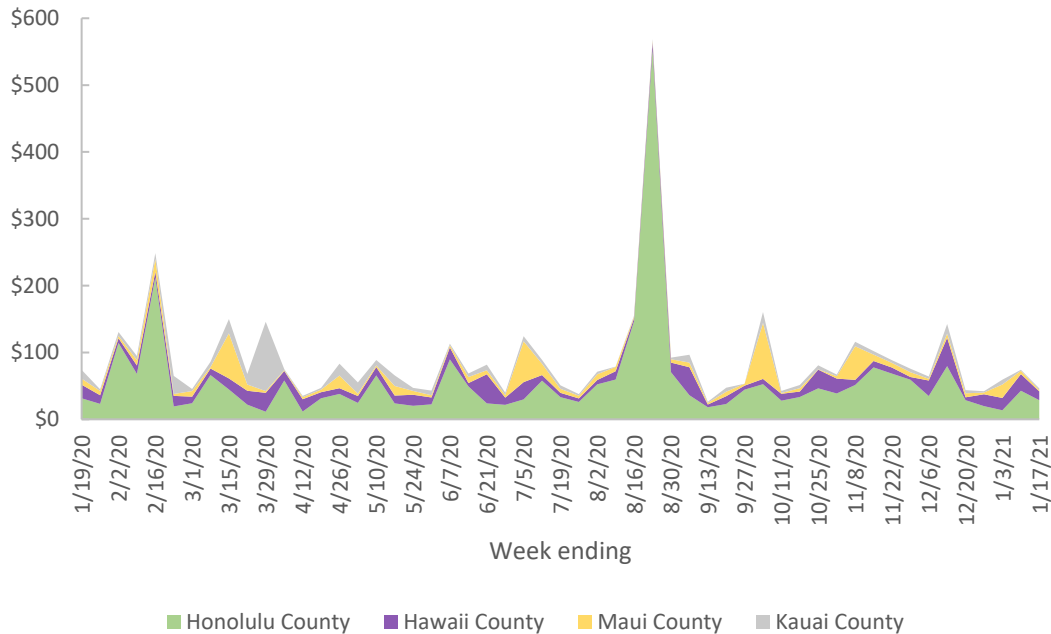

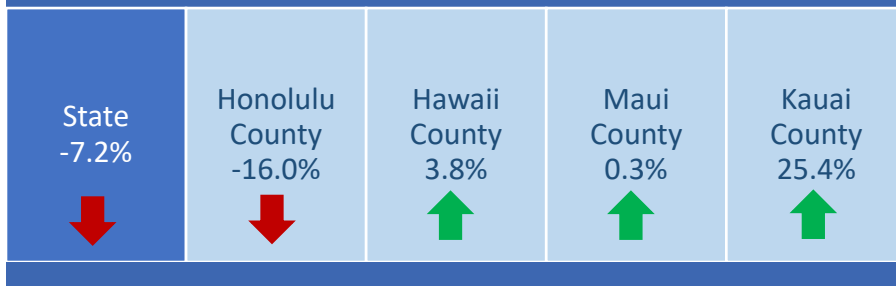

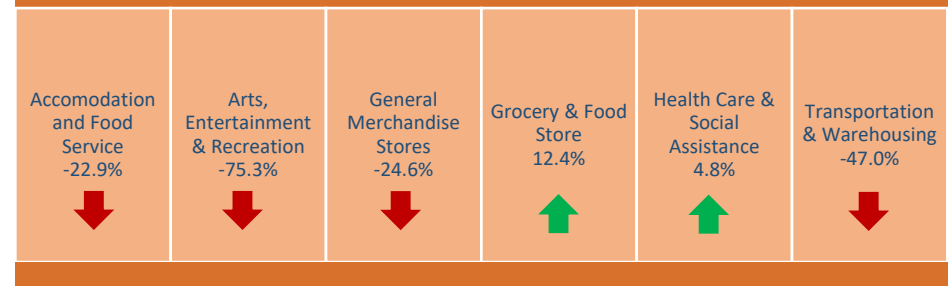
Percent Change in Hawaii Resident Spending by County
