



Daily New COVID-19 Cases per 100,000 Population



Daily New COVID-19 Cases per 100,000 Population, by State 7-day average







Percent Change in Number of Small Businesses in Operation (Compared to January 2020)




Percent Change in Small Business Revenue (Compared to January 2020)

Change in Retail and Recreation Visits




Change in Workplace Visits






Total operating revenues/sales/receipts in the last month



Change in Jobs from Prior Year (Current Month) January 2021








Percentage of adults who...




Missed rent/mortgage payments and plan to the next month

Find it difficult to pay usual household expenses




