



#### Daily New COVID-19 Cases per 100,000 Population



Daily New COVID-19 Cases per 100,000 Population, by State 7-day average







# Percent Change in Number of Small Businesses in Operation (Compared to January 2020)




# Percent Change in Small Business Revenue (Compared to January 2020)

### **Change in Retail and Recreation Visits**




#### **Change in Workplace Visits**







Total operating revenues/sales/receipts in the last month



# Change in Jobs from Prior Year (Current Month) February 2021








At times did have not enough to eat in the last 7 days




