II. Asset/Land/Property Management

- A. Kakaako Waterfront Park/Kakaako Makai Gateway Park/Kewalo Basin Park
 - 1. In December 2016 there were 14 park use permits issued and no school group permits issued.
 - 2. In December 2016, there were no vehicles towed during normal park hours and 3 that were towed after park hours for illegal parking.

B. Reserved Housing

- 1. In December 2016, staff approved 4 subordinations for owners wishing to refinance their reserved housing units.
- 2. In December 2016, staff denied 1 subordination request.
- 3. In December 2016, there were no reserved housing unit buy backs during their regulated term.
- 3. In December 2016, staff approved 1 Release of Unilateral Agreement to allow Reserved Housing owners to pay off the shared equity due to the HCDA upon sale of the unit outside of the regulated term.

C. Right of Entry Agreements

1. In December 2016, staff issued 3 new Right of Entry agreements for various parcels as noted in Exhibit B. There are currently 14 Right of Entry agreements that will remain in place through December 2016, as noted in Exhibit B.

D. Park Updates

Park Rule Amendment Public Hearing

1. The Amendments to the Park Rules were approved by the HCDA on January 4, 2017 and will be transmitted to the Governor for signature before being formally adopted.
