Act 009 2017 Session Laws of Hawaii

On April 18, 2019, HCDA served the Kakaako Land Company a Notice of Order demanding \$250,000 in fines for non-compliance with the law. Kakaako Land Company has 30 days to petition the Authority for a contested case hearing or the order will become final.

II. Asset/Land/Property Management

City Land Transfer Update

The City and County of Honolulu and HCDA are working toward closing the lands transfer by May 31, 2019. The previously extended right of entry agreement (ROE) to allow the City to continue enforcing its rules and ordinances in the Kakaako Makai area prior to the transfer was will also expire on May 31, 2019.

As part of the transfer, the HCDA is currently procuring a land survey of the rock revetment at Kakaako Waterfront Park and Kewalo Basin Park. The City will take over maintenance of the revetment when it assumes ownership of the adjacent park land.

HCDA will also update several title reports prior to conveyance to provide clean title to the City. This is expected to cost about \$500.

Park Permits

The HCDA continues to work with the City and County of Honolulu Department of Parks and Recreation to manage the parks and permit future events. Per City guidelines, only alcohol-free, non-commercial events held by non-profit organizations are currently allowed at the Kakaako Makai parks.

HCDA is processing the following park permits after receiving approval from the City and County:

- 1. Filipino Fiesta, May 4, 2019 (Gateway Parks)
- 2. Friends of Kewalos Beach Cleanup, June 1, 2019 (Kewalo Basin Park)
- 3. NSSA Surf Amateur Surf Competition, May 4, 2019 (Point Panic)

The following events are pending approval by the City and County:

- 1. Democratic Party Community Clean up, May 11, 2019 (Waterfront Park)
- 2. Shangri La Museum for Islamic Art, Culture & Design Concert June 3, 2019 (Waterfront Park amphitheater)

Parking Enforcement

Due to numerous complaints of illegal parking at Kewalo Basin Park, HCDA's security contractor has been monitoring the Kewalo Basin Park parking lot daily and towing those parked illegally. Park rules require that patrons use the park while parking in the parking lot. The security contractor follows a specific protocol to enforce this rule.

In April 2019, four vehicles were towed for violating parking rules at the Kewalo Basin Park parking lot. Three vehicles were towed from the Kakaako Waterfront Park parking lot.

Reserved Housing

In April 2019, no requests for subordination were processed.

In April 2019, no requests to sell a reserved housing unit during its regulated term were processed.

In April 2019, no Releases of Unilateral Agreement were executed.

In April 2019, there were fifteen (15) inquiries relating to Reserved Housing Rules and Regulations.

<u>Right of Entry Agreements</u>
