II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

III. <u>INFORMATION AND DISCUSSION</u>

Update: Performance Evaluation Taskforce of the Hawaii Community Development Authority Executive Director.

Information: Monthly Financial Report for April 2019

Mr. Garett Kamemoto referred to the report provided in the board packet.

Member Waterhouse asked what fund the emergency appropriation, recently approved by the Governor, would go to.

Mr. Kamemoto explained that because the emergency appropriation is a recent approval that came out of the 2019 legislative session, there is a process to request a release of those monies from the Governor's office and will take some time to be deposited into HCDA's fund. Mr. Kamemoto noted that he would need to check with Ms. Miyasaki, HCDA ASO to follow up on what fund that monies would be deposited.

Member Swinney asked what line item #3 "Personnel Services" expenses are for.

Member Waterhouse confirmed line item #3 - Personnel Services are for the HCDA Attorney General salaries.

There were no comments by board members and no public testimony.

Information: 2019 Legislative Update

Mr. Kamemoto explained that HCDA is tasked to complete a few studies that came out of the 2019 legislative session. Staff will start to work on those studies which include: reviewing Kakaako properties for a Fire station; a study to transition the Kakaako community Development District to the City and County of Honolulu; and Managing the Heeia State Park.

There were no comments by board members and no public testimony.
