Planning

Kalaeloa Plan and Rules Update

The Kalaeloa Plan and Rules consultants Torti Gallas+Partners (TG+P), Townscape Inc. and Linda Colburn (Plan and Rules Team) reported they completed all landowner's meetings and is in the process of putting together a Kalaeloa Master Plan draft. The goal is to complete the draft by the end of March. A meeting to brief the Kalaeloa permitted interaction group and a district virtual charrette will be tentatively scheduled for April.

Tracy Arakaki Productions, LLC – Potential Motorsport Exhibition

HCDA staff met with Mr. Arakaki to return original signed documents. New information was submitted for the Conditional Use of Vacant Land Permit for the Kalaeloa Motorsports Exhibition and Education (Exhibition) event should be deemed complete by March 15, 2021. The Exhibition is proposed for a 2-acre parcel owned and authorized by Kalaeloa Ventures, LLC/Hunt Companies.

Arion Energy LLC - Potential Kalaeloa Home Lands Solar Project

HCDA staff met with Arion Energy LLC (Arion) regarding the new design layout of its proposed solar project. In 2018, Arion obtained rights to develop a Hawaiian Electric Company (HECO) Community-Based Renewable Program (CBRE) solar project on 29.8 acres owned by the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands. HCDA staff is reviewing the draft development permit application and has requested the deputy attorney general to review and advise on conducting a conditional use permit hearing. The goal is to deem the application complete by the end of March.

Hunt Companies

HCDA staff met with Hunt Companies to discuss Hunt's master planning efforts and plans to make an informational presentation to update the Authority in March. HCDA staff had discussions with the State Historic Preservation Division (SHPD) staff regarding the proposed project. SHPD staff is in the process of reviewing the Archaeological Monitoring Plan submitted for the project. The Veteran's Multi-Plex project targeted for Kalaeloa is still pending final Federal approval.

Department of Health

HCDA staff met with the State of Hawaii Department of Health (DOH) staff regarding illegal entry and camping at the Navy's abandoned telecommunications building along Coral Sea Road. Although the Navy still owns the land and building the parcel is part of the 400 acres

road. The building is located on a parcel of land targeted to be transferred to the City and County of Honolulu Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR). DOH and DPR staff is working to secure the building and remove any potential lead mineral items or other hazardous materials that was being stolen from the building.

Department of Transportation Airport (DOT-A) – Potential Kalaeloa Airport Tenant HCDA staff received notice DOT-A will be submitting a final permit application for building a new fuel farm at the Kalaeloa Airport. The current fuel provider at Kalaeloa Airport has concerns about this project and negative impact this new project may have on small business. HCDA staff is in the process of retrieving information.
