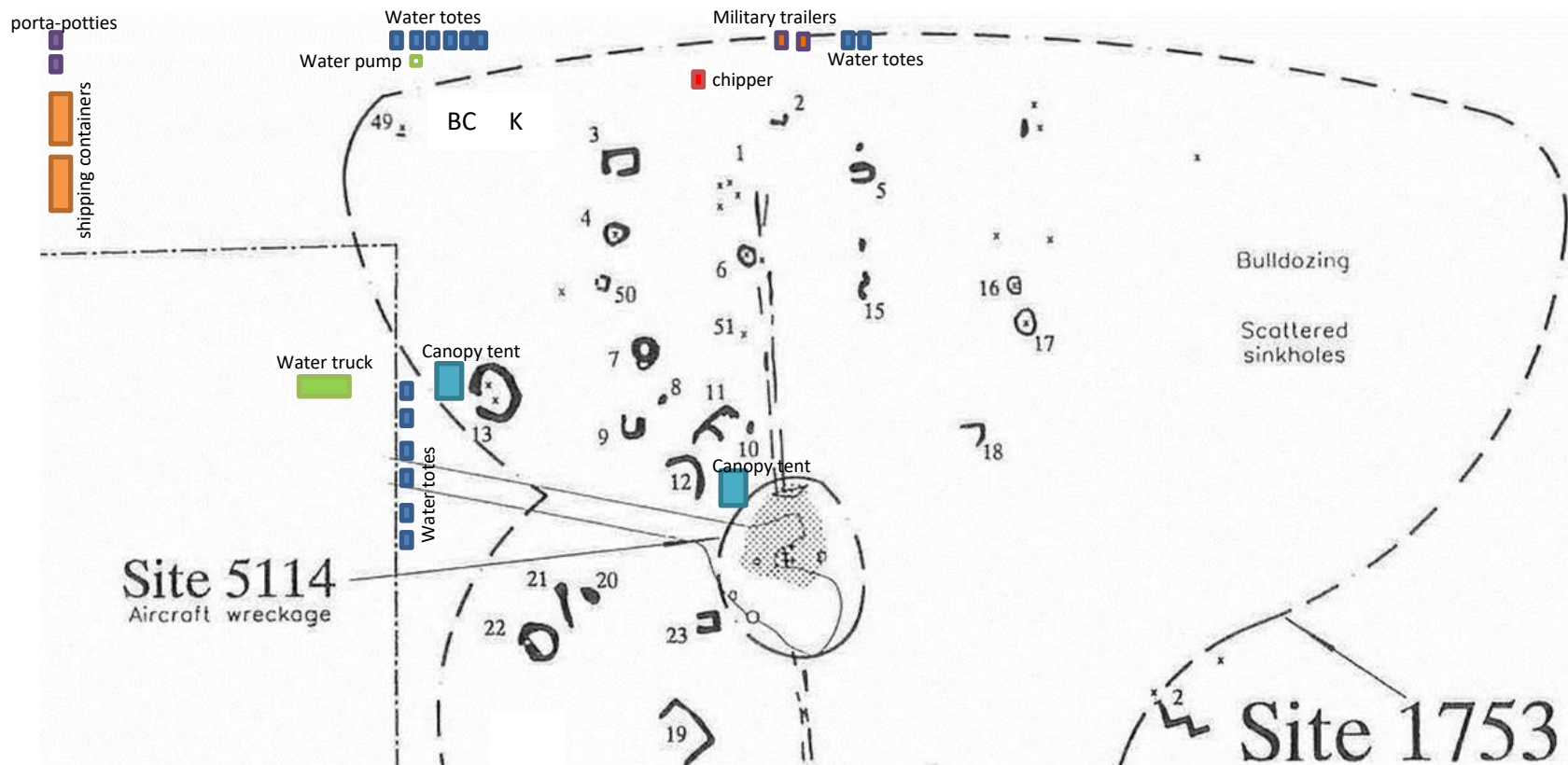


Figure 1 - TMK 9-1-013069 Inventory Map

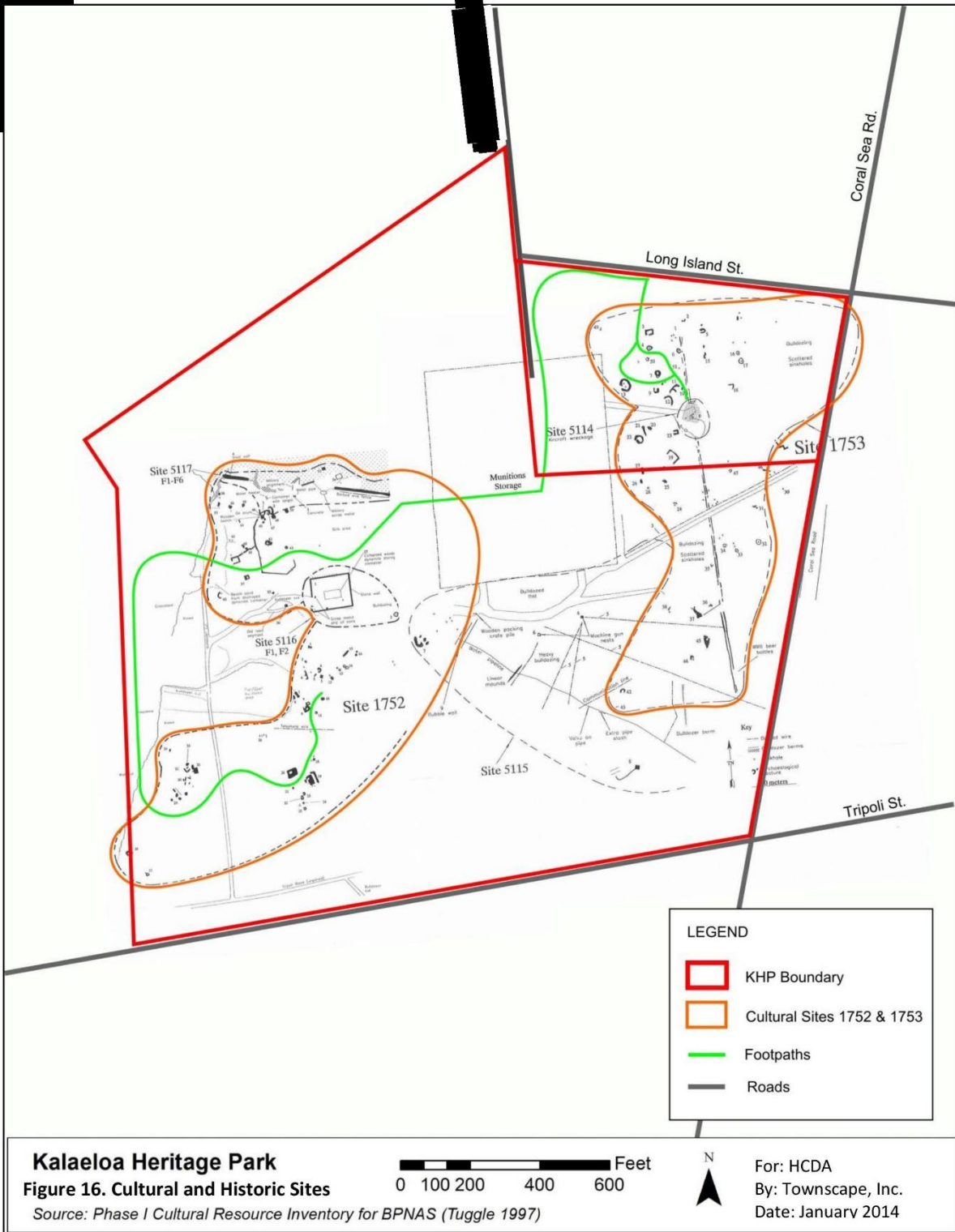


Figure 2 - Cultural and History Sites by TMK
