I. SUBJECT

Status Update: Presentation by Herman Tuiolosega, Planner, regarding the State of Hawai'i Department of Transportation's Existing Master Plan for the Kalaeloa Airport, including current and future projects and developments and Proposed Amendment to the same, located at Tax Map Key: (1) 9-1-013-032 [300 Midway Street, Kapolei, HI 96707].

II. BACKGROUND

The Kalaeloa Airport is located on approximately 756 acres of land owned by the State of Hawaii Department of Transportation Airports Division (HDOT-A) -- or about 19% of the total area (land parcels) of the Kalaeloa Community Development District.

State projects on the Kalaeloa airport property have been historically exempted from permit reviews, since § 206E-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), allows for State and City agencies to undertake projects in consultation with the HCDA. In addition, the Kalaeloa Community Development District Rules designate the airport as a Special District (SD) zone that is governed by the standards of the Federal Aviation Administration.

III. DISCUSSION

In order to satisfy the inter-agency consultation requirement in a programmatic fashion, Mr. Herman Tuiolosega of the DOT-A planning division will discuss some upcoming development projects at the Kalaeloa Airport. These are shown in the attached handout. In addition, the ¹Kalaeloa Airport Master Plan is expected to be updated within the near future.
