# **Developments Under-Construction**

There are ten (10) major projects under construction in Kakaako:

- The 803 Waimanu project's (KAK 13-091) developer still has plans to construct enhancements to the recreation deck amenities.
- Residents have moved into the Koula project (KAK 18-038). The first and second level commercial unit storefronts and interior improvements have yet to be installed.
- Victoria Place (KAK 19-069) vertical superstructure was topped off in April, and construction is ongoing.
- The Ililani project (an HHFDC 201H Project) vertical superstructure construction is ongoing.
- The Ala Moana Pedestrian Bridge is under construction. The bridge will link Kewalo Basin Harbor to the Victoria Ward Park, mauka of Ala Moana Boulevard.
- The Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation is relocating utilities for the Honolulu Rail Transit Project along Halekauwila Street.
- The foundation permit for The Park at Ward Village (KAK 21-002) was approved and sitework is underway.
- Construction has commenced for Ulana Ward Village (KAK 21-001).
- The building at 250 Ward Avenue will be demolished to facilitate the construction of the Pohukaina Street extension to Auahi Street.

### Ordinance 16-21 Certification Requests

HCDA staff processed five (5) new requests related to infrastructure improvements, pursuant to the City and County of Honolulu's Ordinance 16-21. To date, HCDA has received and processed twenty-eight (28) Ordinance 16-21 certification requests for the calendar year.

## II. Asset/Land/Property Management

### Reserved Housing

In October-November 2023, two Subordinations of Equity Sharing Payment Agreements were executed to allow reserved housing unit owners to refinance their mortgages. This includes one approval for a second mortgage, which is allowable under certain conditions. One other request for a second mortgage subordination was received and is pending further action.

In October-November 2023, there were no requests to sell a reserved housing unit during its regulated term.

In October-November 2023, one Release of Unilateral Agreement was executed, generating a total of \$174,500.00 in shared equity payment to the HCDA.

One other request for Unilateral Release was received in October-November 2023 and is pending further action.

In October-November 2023, there were 23 inquiries relating to Reserved Housing Rules and Regulations.

### New Contracts/ Lease Updates

In October, a professional services contract with RMA Architects, Inc. was executed for architecture and engineering services to modernize two (2) passenger elevators at the HCDA Kauhale Kakaako Parking Garage.

### Kauhale Kakaako Garage Elevator Maintenance Contract

The current garage elevator maintenance contract with Elevator Services, LLC expires on January 31, 2024, with no additional options to extend. The HCDA issued an Invitation for Bids (IFB) solicitation, for a new contract, on September 22, 2023. The solicitation closed on October 16, 2023, with Elevator Services, LLC being the lowest responsive, responsible, qualified bidder. On October 23, 2023, a Notice of Award was issued to Elevator Services, LLC for \$104,280.00 for the initial 3-year term, which includes a \$30,000 annual allowance for pre-approved additional services. Staff is currently working on contract documents to execute the new contract prior to the expiration of the current contract.

Kauhale Kakaako Garage Parking Management and Security Services Contract The current parking management and security services contract with Diamond Parking Services LLC expires on December 31, 2023, with no additional options to extend. The HCDA issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for a new contract on October 31, 2023. Proposals from interested offerors were due on December 1, 2023, and the RFP evaluation committee will make a recommendation for award that will be reported in next month's ED Report.

### Right of Entry Agreements

There were 10 active Right of Entry (ROE) and/or license agreements through November 2023. See Exhibit A.

### III. Capital Improvements

### Kakaako Street Improvements

Wilson Okamoto & Associates continue their professional services contract for roadway and infrastructure improvement planning and engineering in the Central Kakaako, on Ilaniwai and Kamani Streets. Planning and community outreach activities are planned for December 2023 and January 2024.

# Queen Street Crosswalk Improvements

The HCDA staff has contracted Haron Construction to complete the planned permanent crosswalk improvements on Queen Street, at the Kolowalu Park. Work outside of the roadway will be conducted first, while the contractor waits for HECO approval of the electrical permit; the work outside the roadway is expected to commence on December 11, 2023. Haron plans to conduct any roadway closures on Queen Street within the HDOT guidelines for holiday work schedules. No traffic impacts are expected at this time, on Queen Street, within the work areas.

Howard Hughes Corp. (HHC) has planned for several archaeological survey trenches in the vicinity of the crosswalk works. This work is currently planned for December. All HHC work will be coordinated with HCDA contractors through the HCDA construction managers, Limtiaco Group.

### Kolowalu Dog Park

The HCDA has contracted Bolton Inc. to construct the planned dog park improvements on the Mauka side of Kolowalu park. Construction activities will commence on the week of November 20th. Initial activities include: mobilization; site fencing; best management practices; site clearing; and trench work. ASM Affiliates is contracted by HCDA to conduct archeological observations during any ground disturbances. Construction activities are scheduled to continue through the holiday season.
