Wednesday, November 17, 2025 MINUTES

I. CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL

The Hawai'i Community Development Authority ("Authority" or "Board"), a body corporate and a public instrumentality of the State of Hawai'i ("State") met in person at the HCDA's physical meeting site, American Brewery Building, 547 Queen Street, 2nd Floor Boardroom and provided an option to attend virtually (utilizing the State-supported Zoom Meeting platform) for a Special meeting on November 17, 2025.

Chairperson Sterling Higa called the November 17, 2025, HCDA Kalaeloa Authority Special meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Acknowledgment that the Meeting is Being Convened Virtually

Executive Director Craig Nakamoto reiterated the wording contained in the Meeting Agenda regarding the guidelines and directives provided by Section 92-3.7, Hawai'i Revised Statutes ("HRS"), to enable public boards and commissions to conduct business virtually with a meeting site open to the public.

II. DECISION MAKING

In Re the Petition of Tara Rojas Regarding the Proposed Amendments to the Kalaeloa Community Development District Plan and Rules, DOCKET NO. CCH 2025-01:

- a. Pursuant to HAR § 15-219-48, shall the Authority assign the petition requesting a contested case hearing for further proceedings before a hearings officer as provided in HAR § 15-219-26?
- b. Shall the Authority authorize the Executive Director to take all actions necessary to retain a hearings officer and facilitate the contested case hearing?

Mr. Craig Nakamoto, Executive Director, presented the staff report and exhibits provided in the board packet. He summarized that i) the petition for a contested case was filed pursuant to HAR § 15-219-46 by the petitioner, ii) the contested case was initiated, iii) the Authority shall either assign the initiated contested case before the Authority or before a hearings officer, and iv) a hearings officer, if so appointed, shall have all the powers of the Chair and authority of the board members. He concluded with the recommendation that the Authority assign the subject matter for further proceedings before a hearings officer.

There were no comments or questions from the board members.

There was no motion to convene in Executive Session pursuant to HRS §92-5 (a)(4).

Public Testimony

Chair Higa called for public testimony. There were no inquiries to provide oral testimony, and no written testimonies were received.
