

Joe Ferraro co-founded Ferraro Choi And Associates Ltd. with Gerald Choi in February 1988. Before founding Ferraro Choi Mr. Ferraro was a Principal and Director of Interior Architecture of the CJS Group Architects from 1982-88. Before moving to Hawaii in 1982, he was Vice-President of Sheridan Associates (formerly Raymond Loewy International) in New York. Mr. Ferraro has served as an adjunct faculty member and juror for University of Hawaii School of Architecture, and the Honolulu AIA Design Awards program. His work has been published in Hawaii Business, Hawaii Architect, Dwell, Wired, Interiors, Lighting Design, The New York Times Science Section, and Science. Mr. Ferraro is the architect of record for a number of notable projects including the Information Technology Center at the University of Hawaii at Manoa, the Amundsen-Scott South Pole Station, the Cryogenic Laboratory at McMurdo Station and associate architect for the MOAA IRC.
