

## HAWAII HOUSING FINANCE AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION Consolidated Application Round – April 17, 2020

In light of the Governor's Proclamation and guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation (HHFDC) has updated the policy for the acceptance of applications for Low Income Housing Tax Credits (LIHTC), Hula Mae Multi-Family Bonds (HMMF), and Dwelling Unit Revolving Funds (DURF) to mitigate the spread of the Coronavirus disease.

- 1. Applications are due by April 17, 2020, 2:00 pm (no change).
- 2. HHFDC will continue to accept applications (original and two copies) in person during the following days/hours:
  - a. April 17, 2020: 7:45 am 2:00 pm
  - b. April 13-16, 2020: By appointment. Please contact us at least 24 hours in advance to schedule an appointment:
