

RENT RELIEF AND HOUSING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

State Prepares to Launch Rent Relief and Housing Assistance Program Early September

In accordance with Act 9, enabling the State to assist renters that are at risk of eviction and homeowners facing mortgage foreclosure impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, HHFDC is finalizing plans with non-profit partners to administer The Rent Relief and Housing Assistance program early September. The program will assist households that have experienced job loss or reduction in income due to COVID-19. The program is funded through the Federal CARES Act which expires on December 30, 2020.

What to expect:

- Target start date to accept applications is late early September
- The program will be administered by non-profits partners
- Payments will be made by the non-profits directly to landlords or mortgage servicers for eligible primary residences in the State of Hawaii
- · Financial counseling and mortgage loan modifications

Program Eligibility

- · Full-time residents occupying their primary residence in the State of Hawaii
- 18 years of age or older
- Demonstrated loss of income directly resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic
- · Household income of 100% AMI or below
